

IDnext privacy statement

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 This statement is meant to inform you about the processing of personal data by Stichting IDnext association (hereafter: IDnext), registered at the Dutch Chamber of Commerce under number 50098551.

1.2 IDnext is the 'controller' for the processing operations set out in this statement within the meaning of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). IDnext can be contacted at:

2. PERSONAL DATA

2.1 We process the following categories of personal data:

If you are a visitor to our website www.idnext.eu (hereafter: the Website), a visitor to our events, or have contact with us:

- Name and contact information such as your email address if you contact us or subscribe to events;
- Payment details when you have purchased access to paid events or other events;
- Browsing and click-behaviour on the Website and newsletters.

If you are a volunteer at IDnext, member of the board or advisory committee, or mentioned in one of our articles on the Website:

- If you are a volunteer at IDnext, your name, address and some information regarding reimbursements is processed to carry out the volunteer agreement;
- Some bio information, including a photograph is used to introduce and provide information to the public about members of the board and the advisory committee;
- In our articles and publications, personal data such as names, photographs and information regarding professional activities is processed when this is relevant to the discussed subject.

3. PURPOSES AND LEGAL GROUNDS

3.1 We process your personal data for the following purposes:

- Communication between you and IDnext, regarding questions and requests;
- Carrying out our services. This primarily includes organizing events, for which we need lists of contact info of visitors;
- Sending of newsletters and other communication regarding useful news about the IDnext platform, including information and updates from our partners. If you have visited an event and are on our mailing list, we will place you on a mailing list that is more fitting to the subject of the event;
- If you have purchased a service from us, such as a paid event, we may use your email address obtained in the context of this service, to send you relevant updates and newsletters for related services and products. You have a right to object to this;
- Evaluating our events by requesting our visitors (by email) to fill out a questionnaire, the results of which will be stored anonymously;
- Analysing the use of the Website and newsletters, to measure the effectivity of our communication.

3.2 We process personal data on the basis of the following legal grounds:

- Necessary for the performance of a contract with you, if you are party to the contract as a data subject;
- On the basis of a legal obligation, particularly fiscal obligations of fiscal record keeping;

- Legitimate interest of IDnext;
- In certain cases, we need your consent for processing your personal data. You may withdraw your consent at any time. This will not affect the legality of processing activities before the withdrawal (withdrawal has no retroactive effect).

4. COOKIES

4.1 Using cookies, we keep statistics regarding the number of visitors to our Website and which pages are viewed the most. For this purpose, we use tools provided by Google, as part of the "Google Analytics"-service. The information regarding browsing behaviour is stored by Google on servers in the United States. Google is certified under the EU-US Privacy Shield. In this way, appropriate safeguards exist for the transfer of the personal data concerned to a country outside the European Economic Area. Google shares this data with other Google services and may use this data to personalize ads of Google's advertising network.

4.2 You can delete the cookies placed by your browser and you can turn off the acceptance of new cookies. The following pages contain more information regarding the steps to do so for several internet browsers: Chrome Internet Explorer Firefox Safari.

5. STORAGE PERIODS

5.1 IDnext shall not store your personal data for longer periods than necessary for the purposes mentioned in article 2.

5.2 Your personal data may be stored longer in so far this is necessary for complying with legal obligations, such as fiscal record keeping obligations.

6. RECIPIENTS

6.1 IDnext may disclose your personal data, if necessary, to the following categories of recipients:

- IT service providers that provide us with hosting, IT support, email services, event management software and analytics tools.
- An administration service provider for keeping our records.

7. YOUR RIGHTS

7.1 With regard to the processing of your personal data, you have the right to request access to and rectification of your personal data, the right to erasure, data portability, restriction and the right to object to processing. You also have the right to lodge a complaint with the Autoriteit Persoonsgegevens, the Dutch data protection authority <https://autoriteitpersoonsgegevens.nl/en>. We will inform you whether your request is granted as soon as possible. With regard to personal data for direct marketing purposes, you have an absolute right to object. This means the direct marketing will cease after you object to this.

7.2 In so far the processing of personal data is based on your consent, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time. This will not affect the legality of processing activities before the withdrawal (withdrawal has no retroactive effect).

8. CHANGES TO PRIVACY STATEMENT
